



ENGINE CUT-OFF SWITCH. USE IT.



WHAT IS IT?

- · Safety mechanism that shuts off the boat's engine
- Also called ECOS, engine cut-off switch, engine cut-off device, man overboard device

WHY USE IT?

- Reduces the risk of a propeller strike
- Stops the engine if the operator falls overboard
- Stops the engine quickly if needed in an emergency
- · Protects others from a runaway boat
- · Regain control of the boat more quickly
- And, it's the law

DOES MY BOAT HAVE IT?

• Most newer powerboats do

WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE?

It may be a:

- Lanyard—Attaches to the boat operator from the installed engine cut-off switch
- Wireless—A wristband or key fob can be worn by the operator and passengers
